This is a painless (but somewhat impersonal) method of working out how compatible a couple is using computerised astrology.

I filled in a form, jotting down the dates, times and birth places of myself and Max, then watched while the details were fed into a computer and a personalised reading was printed out.

I was expecting the reading to be very vague, but it turned out to be remarkably accurate. Called a Compatibility Profile, the document outlines our temperaments,

emotional rapport, sexual attraction, mental rapport and durability.

According to Robin Currey's computer program, Max's sun falls on my moon and this is a very good sign, because it means we instinctively understand each other (true). Robin writes that 'there is a vast potential for

growth on a spiritual and material plane', which is a fairly solid base for marriage.

Robin also saw a rival sibling feeling between us. He says that when we first met, we may have had a strong feeling of having met before (we did as a matter of fact), and that's because we have a

strong karmic link.

He insists that ours is a serious affair and is destined to last a long time, if we share our innermost thoughts and feelings. We are ultimately good for each other, and marriage may be an option.
